A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LEON, KANSAS DESIGNATING THE HARVEST HOME FESTIVAL TO ALLOW FOR STREET CLOSURES ON SEPTEMBER 16, 2022 and SEPTEMBER 17, 2022.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the City of Leon, Kansas:

WHEREAS, THE City of Leon, Kansas, has allowed the Lion Pride Committee to hold the annual Festival, also referred to as the Harvest Home Festival; and

WHEREAS, the Harvest Home Festival will take place on September 17, 2022.

WHEREAS, the City of Leon has given the Lion Pride Committee to have the Harvest Home Festival from seven a.m. (7:00am) to eleven p.m. (11:00pm).

WHEREAS, the City of Leon governing body has voted to allow the Lion Pride Committee to have an open area beer garden within certain city streets for the Harvest Home Festival.

WHEREAS, the City of Leon has allowed for the following street closures: the 100 block of West Mechanic St., the 100 and 200 block of North Main St., the 100 block of South Main St., and the 100 block of West and East Central St. for September 16, 2022 after 9:00 pm until September 17, 2022 no later than 11:59 pm.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF LEON that the City of Leon, Kansas shall grant permission to close the streets and to have an open beer garden for the Harvest Home Festival.
