ORDINANCE NO. 2023-02

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF LEON PERTAINING TO ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the City of Leon:

SECTION 1: Section 3-302 of the City Code is amended to read as follows:

3-302 Occupational tax.

There is hereby levied a biennial occupation tax of one hundred (\$100) dollars on any person holding a license issued by the state director of alcoholic beverage control for the retail sale within the city of alcoholic liquors for consumption off the premises. Such tax shall be paid by the retailer to the city clerk before business is begun under an original state license and shall be paid within five days after any renewal of a state license.

SECTION 2: Section 3-304 of the City Code is amended to read as follows:

3-304. Hours of Sale.

No person shall sell at retail any alcoholic liquor:

- (a) On Easter Sunday, Thanksgiving Day, and/or Christmas Day
- (b) Before 9:00 a.m. or after 11:00 p.m. on Monday through Saturday when the sale thereof is permitted.
 - (c) Before 12:00 p.m. or after 8:00 p.m. on Sunday when the sale thereof is permitted.

SECTION 3: Any Ordinances or Code provisions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its adoption by the governing body of the City, approval by the Mayor and publication once in the official newspaper of the City. The official newspaper of the City is the city website: www.cityofleon.org.
