

During the second week of June, Everett "Doc" Watkins competed three days in the 133rd Kansas State Shoot in Trapshooting. This was Doc's 51st time competing at the state shoot. Doc grew up in southeast Kansas where at the age of 10, he was already hunting with a rifle. Doc enlisted in the United States Army in 1952. He was stationed at Fort Riley, Kansas where he attained the rank of Sergeant and served as an instructor, teaching troops how to use their weapons in the most efficient way. Doc started shooting trap in 1972 and to date, has shot 120,000 registered targets. He has received many trophies over the years, some of which are pictured. Doc won Kansas State High Over All Senior Veteran awards in 1999, 2002, 2004, 2006, 2007, 2008 and 2009. Over the years as a high school teacher and trapshoot coach, Doc took ten Bluestem High School teams to the state shoot. Doc's results from three days at the 2023 Kansas State Shoot were 83/100, 90/100 and 84/100. Those are outstanding results for anyone but particularly so for a 92-year-old!
